Administrative Support

Detail orientated & organized volunteers are needed to help with administrative tasks. Opportunities are available in both Menasha & Oshkosh offices to help with data entry, filing, answering phones and other office projects.

Children's Program

This area is for these volunteers who are kids at heart. Volunteers are needed to give children at the Center attention, support, education, and guidance.

GROUP: Volunteers assist in the implementation of group and individuals activities to stimulate growth in language, social & motor skills, and health play with others. They assist in presenting basic skill groups & redirecting inappropriate behavior. Commitment of 1 night (Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday) from 5:45 – 7:45pm

RESPIRE: Volunteers assist by providing both mother & child a break from one another. You assist by coming in and spending 1-2 hours with child/children by playing, participating in activities, tutoring and most of all to have fun.

Community Outreach & Education

It takes a lot of work to inform and educate the community about the issues of domestic abuse. Community Education is a major focus of our agency. If you are looking at improving your connections, meeting people in the public and making a difference for victims of domestic violence this might be the area for you. We are looking for individuals to assist by distributing information, and representing Christine Ann at various booths/fairs and community events and helping deliver presentations throughout Winnebago and Green Lake Counties. Specific training will be offered.

Group Projects

Meals that Heal

Individuals & Groups are wanted to provide meals to our shelter residents. This opportunity is available 7 days a week - Monday - Friday for dinner and Saturday or Sunday for breakfast, lunch or dinner. We ask that volunteers provide the food and/or components necessary for making the meal. Volunteers can commit to a meal by contacting our Volunteer Coordinator and to arrange a date/meal – we will then be in touch a week and then again a few days prior with the number of women & children in shelter.

Shelter & Helpline Coverage

Calm, cool, and collected are all words that would describe the volunteers needed in this area. Volunteers assist by greeting and directing clients and/or donors, answering phones, scheduling appointments, taking reports from Winnebago & Green Lake police departments regarding domestic violence incidents in addition to handling information and referral calls

Social Media

Do you enjoy writing about newsworthy stories, posting on message boards or blogging ~ what about documenting through pictures? If you enjoy these you can help the Christine Ann Center inform the public about domestic violence. Many opportunities are available – position is flexible and can be virtual.
